


WELCOME TO OUR SUPERHERO TEAM!

A dairy cow can give four gallons of milk a day, making it a moo-velous addition to any family farm.

CHICKENS

TREE SEEDLINGS

Biogas stoves use methane gas captured from animal poo to burn cleanly and efficiently.


SCHOOL FOR KIDS



Khardiata lives in Senegal, a country in Africa. It only rains four months a year there, so sometimes it's hard to find water. Every day before and after school, Khardiata helps her mother with the chores, which includes collecting water.

Now, families in her village have a cleaner, more accessible source of water through the Heifer Senegal project. A newly built well provides families like Khardiata's with year-round access to clean water for their families, animals and crops.

Khardiata and her family eat the eggs from the chickens Heifer provided, giving more protein to their diet. They can also sell extra eggs or chickens. With the money they earn, Khardiata can go to school again.
